A portion of a **Message from Bishop Barber** to All of the Faithful of the Diocese:

"Our world is in need of renewal. Too many of our brothers and sister are hurting and in need of healing-but too many of us are in turn separated from the very source of our strength: Our Lord Jesus Christ.

"To revive our connection to Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, I am calling for our Diocese to join in the National Eucharistic Revival to reflect upon the centrality of the Eucharist in our lives and to reaffirm our call to be a people nourished, fed, and renewed by the Eucharist itself....

"It is my prayer that as we all reinvigorate our devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and deepen our formation on the Real Presence, we will in turn be inspired to missionary action. Jesus is here and will renew us.

"As part of this Revival, I am calling for a Diocesan Eucharistic Revival Conference in 2023 with the theme: 'I am with you Always.'

"Save the dates: September 8-9 for the Spanish language track; September 15-16 for the English-language track. More details are forthcoming.

"I know these weekends will be a wonderfully renewing time of prayer, talks, discussion, Mass, Adoration, and a public procession of the Blessed Sacrament....It is time to revive and rekindle the fire of the Eucharist in our hearts."

INTROIT Isaías 45: 8 : Psalm 18: 2

RORATE cœli, dēsuper, et nubes pluant justum: aperiātur terra, et gēminet Salvatōrem. Ps. Cœli enārrant glōriam Dei: et opera mānuum ejus annūntiat firmamentum. Glōria Patri.

Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Saviour. Ps. The heavens show forth the glory of God: and the firmament declareth the work of His hands. Glory be to the Father.

EPISTLE 1Corinthians4: 1-5

FRATRES: Sic nos existimet homo ut ministros Christi, et dispensatōres mysteriōrum Dei. Hic jam quāeritur inter dispensatōres, ut fidēlis quis inveniātur. Mihi autem pro minimo est, ut a vobis jūdicer aut ab humāno die: sed neque meipsum jūdico. Nihil enim mihi cōscius sum: sed non in hoc justificātus sum: qui autem jūdicat me, Dōminus est. Itaque nolite ante tempus judicāre, quoadūsque vēniat Dōminus: qui et illuminābit abscondita tenebrarū, et manifestābit consilia cōrdium: et tunc laus erit unicūque a Deo.

Brethren, let a man so account of us as of the ministers of Christ and the dispensers of the mysteries of God. Here now it is required among the dispensers that a man be found faithful. But to me it is a very small thing to be judged by you or by man's day: but neither do I judge my own self. For I am not conscious to myself of anything: yet am I not hereby justified, but He that judgeth me is the Lord. Therefore judge not before the time, until the Lord come; who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise from God.

Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and Philip his brother tetrarch of Iturea and the country of Trachonitis, and Lysanias tetrarch of Abilina, under the high-priests Annas and Caiphas: the word of the Lord was made unto John, the son of Zachary, in the desert. And he came into all the country about the Jordan, preaching the baptism of penance for the remission of sins, as it was written in the book of the sayings of Isaías the prophet: A voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare ye the way of the Lord: make straight His paths: every valley shall be filled: and every mountain and hill shall be brought low, and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways plain: and all flesh shall see the salvation of God.

## PREFACE OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

VERE dignum et justum est, aequum et salutare, nos tibi semper, et ubique gratias agere: Domine sancta, Pater omnipotens, aeternae Deus. Qui cum unigenito Filio: tuo et Spiritu Sancto, unus es Deus, unus es Dominus: non in unius singularitate personae, sed in unius Trinitatis substantiae. Quo denique de tua Gloria, revelante te, credimus, hoc de Filio tuo, hoc de Spiritu Sancto, sine differentia discretionis sentimus. Ut in confessione verare, sempiternaeque Deitatis, et in personis proprietates, et in essentiali unitas, et in maiestate adoretur aequalitas. Quam laudant Angeli atque Archangeli, Cherubim, quoque ac Seraphim: qui non cessant clamare quotidie, una voce dicentes:

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times and in all places, give thanks unto Thee, O holy Lord, Father almighty, everlasting God: Who, together with Thine only-begotten Son, and the Holy Ghost, are one God, one Lord: not in the oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance. For what we believe by Thy revelation of Thy glory, the same do we believe of Thy Son, the same of the Holy Ghost, without difference or separation. So that in confessing the true and everlasting Godhead, distinction in persons, unity in essence, and equality in majesty may be adored. Which the Angels and Archangels, the Cherubim also and Seraphim do praise: who cease not daily to cry out with one voice saying:

Behold a Virgin shall conceive and bear a son: and His name shall be called Emmanuel.
