

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI Requiescat in pace

In his July 7, 2007 letter to the Bishops of the World on Summorum Pontificum, Pope Benedict XVI wrote:

"As for the use of the 1962 Missal as a Forma extraordinaria of the liturgy of the Mass, I would like to draw attention to the fact that this Missal was never juridically abrogated and, consequently, in principle, was always permitted... What earlier generations held as sacred, remains sacred and great for us too, and it cannot be all of a sudden entirely forbidden or even considered harmful. It behooves all of us to preserve the riches which have developed in the Church's faith and prayer, and to give them their proper place."

Pope Benedict's great care and love for the millennia-old liturgical patrimony of the Holy Roman Church will remain ever our example. May this earthly Shepherd of the Church of God who has now left us continue to shepherd and guide us from Heaven. Let us continue each day to pray for the repose of his soul.
